SCOPE OF WORK

Name of the work: Shifting, Laying, Assembling, and Maintenance of MS shore & floating pipeline for the dredging work by Cutter Suction Dredger for North BOT Dock complex at Paradip Port Trust

DESCRIPTION:

Dredging Corporation of India Ltd., (DCI) a Government of India Undertaking is having its Head Office at Port Area Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh and having its Project Offices at different Ports. DCI is deploying its Cutter Suction Dredger for carrying out capital dredging at North BOT Dock complex at Paradip Port. The dredged material will be pumped to the open discharge area at North sea wall in to sea near PPT Gate No.1 about 1.5 KMS distance through floating and shore pipeline. For this purpose, initially it is required to assemble and lay 800 mm dia self- floating pipe of 744m long (approximately 62 joints) and 800mm dia. shore pipeline for length of 2400 mtrs (approx 200 joints). Depending upon the operational requirement, the total floating and shore pipeline is to be extended which may vary to any extent depending on site requirement.

The quantity given in the schedule are only indicative and may increase or decrease, however payment will be made for the actual work done certified by the Site-in-charge on 'as and when required' basis only.

1. **Shifting, Assembly of Self floating pipeline:** The pipeline material i.e. self floating pipes are to be shifted from the South BOT dock / Stock yard inside Paradip Port to the assembly site at North BOT Dock complex. The Tenderer has to arrange necessary tools, tackles, men power, Crane, etc to shift the required pipeline material as per the directions of Site In-charge. For assembling of pipeline, each joint having 20/24 bolts & nuts which will be issued by DCI are to be tightened by inserting gaskets as leak proof. In case of any leakage found on commencement of dredging, the same should be tightened and make leak proof by the Tenderer without any additional charges. For lowering the pipeline into water, suitable capacity of Crane is to be arranged by the Tenderer at his cost. However, for towing of the pipeline, necessary boat will be supplied by DCI. The initial length for laying and assembling of self-floating pipeline is around 744 m (approx 62 joints) and this work shall be executed immediately and the progress of the work should not be less than 100m per day.
2. **Shifting, Laying and Assembly of MS Shore pipeline:** The Tenderer has to arrange necessary tools, tackles, men power, Crane, etc to shift the required MS pipes from the South BOT Dock Complex /stack yard inside Paradip Port to North BOT Dock complex. The shore pipeline will be of 800mm dia. MS pipes of each 12m length with bends wherever necessary. For assembling of pipeline, each joint having 20/24 bolts & nuts which will be issued by DCI. The pipes are to be laid on the shore/ slushy areas to the shore line alignment for 2400 m length at North BOT Dock Complex. Each pipe is to be connected by inserting rubber gaskets. If required, ground is to be leveled for laying of the shore line by means of earth cutting/ using sand filled gunny bags/ making of trestles as per the direction of the Site-in-charge. **For crossings the roads**, pipes shall be laid on the road or by cutting the road and suitable ramps to be laid as directed. The total length of the shore pipeline to be laid is about 2400 m (approx 200 joints). The progress of the work should not be less than 100m per day or as instructed from time to time. The work includes for extension of discharge end pipe, replacement of pipes including rolling /shifting of the pipes from nearby places.

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3. **Maintenance of Floating & Shore pipeline:** For maintenance of FPL, it is required to provide minimum of 3 persons for each shift of 8 hours. For SPL, it is required to provide a minimum of 3 persons for each shift of 8 hrs. If dredging operation is stopped due to break down of Dredger, the maintenance of shore and floating pipeline may not be required or the persons may be engaged for attending pipeline / other project works. However, 1 (one) day notice will be given for the stoppage for maintenance and or for commencement of maintenance of shore and floating pipeline. During maintenance of the shore and floating pipeline, Tenderer has to arrange all the required tools / spanners, bullies, etc. at his cost.
4. The following duties/ works are to be performed during maintenance of floating and shore pipeline:
- Assisting in operation, running and maintenance of Corporation vessel(s)
 - General works connected to dredging and reclamation works, vessels, project office, site office, etc.
 - Extension/ dis-connection of shore & floating pipeline, shifting and re-laying of anchors, tightening of joints and any other job assigned by the Site-in-charge is part of the maintenance work and shall be attended by the persons engaged on shift basis. No additional payment for the above shall be made to the Tenderer.
5. **Joining MS pipes with MS Bends, 'Y' pipe, 'T' pipe, Distance piece, etc:** As and when required, the Tenderer shall be intimated to execute this work of joining MS pipes with 'Y' pipe, etc and the Tenderer shall take up the work immediately as per the instructions of site-in-charge and at any cost, the Tenderer shall ensure that no dredging operation is hampered due to non-completion of the assigned work in time.
6. **Making of ramps:** For laying of shore pipeline across the existing roads / approach to berths, the Tenderer has to make suitable ramp with a minimum slope of 1:10 for smooth running of traffic operation wherever required as per the instructions of site-in-charge. Payment for the actual work done as certified by the site-in-charge shall only be paid per running meter measured along the length of MS pipe.
7. **Making of dead man :-** Dead man are to be prepared by digging trench on shore near take off point with concrete / wooden log and bullies for securing floating pipeline with sling wire / ropes.

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GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Instructions to the Tenderers: The Tender in main sealed cover containing sealed cover -A and another sealed cover-B super scribed with “Shifting, Laying, assembling, and maintenance of MS shore & floating pipeline for the dredging work by Cutter Suction Dredge for North BOT Dock complex at Paradip Port Trust” will be received by Head of the Department (Div-II), Dredging Corporation of India Limited, “Dredge House”, Port Area, Visakhapatnam- 530001 before 1500 hours **on 24.05.2018**. Late tenders are liable to be rejected summarily.
2. The Tenders for the work will be based on two-cover system. The Financial Bid should contain the Tendered amount and should be submitted in a separate seal Cover superscribed as “Cover – B “Financial Bid” of the Tender for “Shifting, Laying, assembling, and maintenance of MS shore & floating pipeline for the dredging work by Cutter Suction Dredger at Paradip Port Trust”. The financial bid shall not contain any thing other than the single sheet of Bill of Quantities duly filled with the competitive rates.
3. The other Tender documents, accompaniments put in another Cover A” Technical Bid of the Tender for “Shifting, Laying, assembling, and maintenance of shore / floating pipeline for North BOT Dock complex at Pradip” shall accompany the documents as mentioned at Clause No.37 of General Terms and Conditions of the Tender.
4. The main cover and cover A “Technical Bid” will be opened at 1530 hours on 24-05-2018 at Tender Room of DCI. Ltd., Visakhapatnam. The Cover B “Financial bid” of those Tenderers found technically qualified will be opened on a suitable date, which will be informed later.
5. The tenderer should study the tender documents carefully; understand the Special and General Conditions before submission of his tender. He may get himself acquainted with the nature and scope of work and the local conditions before quoting the tender.
6. The tenderer shall sign on all pages of the tender documents before submitting his tender.
7. Tenders received without Earnest Money Deposit as specified by way of NEFT/RTGS/ Bank Guarantee as per **Annexure-V** or with lesser amount EMD and which do not fulfill all or any of the conditions stipulated in the Tender or are incomplete in any respect are liable to be rejected summarily.
8. When a tenderer signs the tender in an Indian language, the rates tendered should also be written in the same language. In the case of illiterate Tenderers, a witness should attest the rates tendered.
9. After receipt of work order and within 10 days, the Contractor shall, at his own expense, enter into and execute a Contract Agreement to be prepared by him in the form annexed hereto (**Annexure-VI**). Until such Contract Agreement is executed, the other documents referred to in the definition of the term “Contract” here in before, shall collectively be the Contract

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10. Rates quoted by the tenderer in Item-Rate in figures and words shall be carefully filled in, so that there is no discrepancy in the rates written in figures and words. However, if any discrepancy is found, the rates written in words shall be taken as correct.
11. Special care shall be taken to write the rates in figures as well as in words, in such a way that no interpretation is possible. In case of figures, words “Rs.” should be written before the figures of rupees and words “Paise” should be written at the end, viz. “Rs.2.15 paise”. In case of words, the word “Rupees” should precede and the word “paise” should be written at the end, viz. “Rupees two and fifteen paise only”. If the rate is in whole rupees, it should be written in figures as “Rs.2.00 Paise” and in words as “Rupees two only”.
12. Canvassing in connection with the tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the tenderer, who resorts to canvassing, will be liable for rejection.
13. The tenderer shall furnish along with the tender, details of the previous experience to show that the tenderer can handle and execute the said job successfully within the stipulated period of contract.
14. The EMD shall be refunded to the un-successful Tenderers without interest, after finalization of the Tenders..
15. The successful Bidder’s earnest money deposit will be discharged upon the Bidder signing the contract, and furnishing the performance security,.
16. The earnest money deposit may be forfeited:
 - (a) If a Bidder:
 - (i) withdraws its bid during the period of bid validity specified by the Bidder on the Bid Form, or
 - (ii) does not accept the correction of errors or
 - (b) in the case of a successful Bidder, if the Bidder fails:
 - (i) to sign the contract; or
 - (ii) to furnish performance security.

Performance Security Deposit

17. Within Ten (10) days after receipt of notification of award of the Contract, the Bidder a sum equal to 5% of the of the contract towards Performance Security to the DCI through NEFT/RTGS OR by way of irrevocable, unconditional Bank Guarantee from Scheduled/ Nationalized Indian Bank as Performance Security Deposit in favour of Dredging Corporation of India Limited payable at Visakhapatnam as per Performa at **Annexure VII** enclosed. Bank Guarantee shall be valid till completion of work including extended period, if any.
18. In addition to above, 5% of amount shall be deducted from every running bill till total performance security deposit amounts to 10% of the agreed contract value .

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19. In case the contract is further extended, sum equal to 5% of the contract value for the extended period of contract shall be deposited within 10 days after receiving a letter of extension of contract from DCI.
20. The performance security deposit will not carry any interest. The same will be returned after completion of work duly certified by Project in charge, Paradip. If Bank Guarantee is submitted against Performance Security, it should be valid till completion of work including extended period if any.
21. If any Tenderer backs out after opening of the Tender or after issue of work order or modify his Tender after opening, the EMD of such Tenderer will be forfeited in favour of the Corporation.
22. Bids, which are inconsistent with the nature of work in the opinion of DCI, will be rejected. The tender containing uncalled for remarks or any additional conditions are liable for summary rejection
23. Any bid received by the DCI after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed by the DCI will be rejected and returned unopened to the Bidder.
24. The Contractor's request(s) for monthly bill(s) shall be submitted to the Project Manager, DCIL Paradip in writing, accompanied by an invoice describing, as appropriate, the services performed and upon fulfillment of other obligations stipulated in the Contract.
25. The record is to be maintained by the contractor for the payment of services provided to be certified by DCI representative on daily and must be submitted along with the monthly invoice.
26. Provident Fund and other recoveries of the workers and payment wage slip must be attached to the Bill.
27. The payments are to be made on actual execution of the work. In case the performance of the contractor is not up to the mark, Project Manager is having full authority to restrict the payment proportionately/pro-rata basis. In case if the further performance is not improved after intimating by DCI to do so, Project Manager is the authority to decide to release the part payment or not to release the payment till the performance is improved up to his satisfaction. In this matter, the decision of the Project Manager shall be final and binding on the contractor.
28. Income Tax will be recovered as per Income Tax Act and Certificate to that effect will be issued as per rules.
29. The tender shall remain open and valid for acceptance for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of Technical bids.
30. No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer/ employee in Engineering or Administration duties in an Engineering Dept. of the Govt. of India, is allowed to work as Tenderer for a period of 2 years of his retirement from Government service, without the previous permission of the Govt. of India. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the Tenderer or any of his employees is found at any time to be such a person, who had not obtained the permission of the

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Govt. of India as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagements in the Tenderer's service as the case may be.

31. The tenderer will have to give a certificate that he is not related to any officer of DCI or any officer of the rank of Asst. Secretary or above in the Ministry of Surface Transport, Government of India. The Tenderer should give a declaration along with his tender about the names of the relatives, who are employed in the Dredging Corporation of India Ltd. as per format given at **Annexure-I**.
32. The Tenderer shall give an undertaking that they have not made any payment or illegal gratification to any person/ authority connected with the bid process so as to influence the bid process and have not committed any offence under the PC Act in connection with the bid as per format given at **Annexure-II**.
33. The Tenderer shall disclose any payments made or proposed to be made to any intermediate (agents etc.) in connection with the bid as per format given at **Annexure-II**.
34. The tenderer shall furnish Details of his Bank Account for Electronic Transfer of payments as per format given at **Annexure-III**.
35. The tenderer shall furnish Information regarding any current litigation in which the tenderer is involved as per format given at **Annexure – IV**.
36. Tenderers shall quote their rates only in decimal coinage and not in Annas and Paise. Tenders will be opened in the presence of the tenderers or their authorised representatives at Dredging Corporation of India Ltd., Visakhapatnam, at the time and date specified in the Notice Inviting Tender.
37. All statutory levies, Port dues / charges, licenses, Port Entry passes for men, material, equipment etc. for engaging labour/ equipment, etc., in Paradip Port waters shall be borne by the Tenderer and the rates are deemed to have included for all the expenses, wages, all Taxes except GST, all local levies, etc. applicable and would be applicable during the contract period. The contractor shall pay all taxes, levies, duties, etc. excluding GST which he / she may be liable to pay to the State Government or Government of India or any other authority under any law for the time being in force as on the date of submission of tender in respect of or in accordance with the execution of contract. If any new taxes and / or increase / decrease in existing taxes and duties are imposed subsequently by Central/State Government, the same will be applicable to this contract. The GST will be reimbursed to the contractor subject to production of GST registration number on the invoices by indicating CST component separately.
38. The Tenderer, while executing the work shall be responsible for safety of his workmen employed on Ancillary crafts Pontoon, boat, pipeline works, the personnel of DCI and third parties carried on board the work Boat/ Tug boat. The Corporation shall not be liable for any damage or compensation arising out of any accident or injury to any workmen or other persons or loss of life in employment of the Tenderer and the Tenderer shall indemnify DCI against all such damages or compensations and against all claims, damages, proceedings, costs, charges and expenses, whatsoever in respect of or relating to this contract.
39. The Tenderer should arrange Insurance for the workmen engaged for the pipeline works and the policy should be valid during the entire period of contract.

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40. The Tenderer should comply with all labour laws such as Contract Labour (R&A) Act, Minimum Wages Act, Bonus Act, P.F. Act etc. and other Statutory Enactment applicable to this contract and in force. The Tenderer should pay minimum wages, bonus, CPF, Medical expenses, OT if any, to the workers engaged by him. SPECIAL CONDITIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS

1. The tenderer may inspect the site and acquaint themselves with the scope of work, local conditions regarding work force requirement for the work and satisfy completely before submitting their tender for this work.
2. Shore pipeline is required to be laid on sand / slushy area as per the direction of site in-charge/ DCI representative. The length of the shore pipe line varies as per the requirement. No claim will be entertained for idleness of the work force. The work has to be carried out in such a way that the dredger will not be stopped for want of pipeline at any stage. The work shall be commenced within Seven days from the date of issue of work order or as stipulated in the work order and to be completed within stipulated time or the progress of work should be at the minimum rate of 100m per day, failing which liquidated damage as applicable will be imposed.
3. To attend to the maintenance work of floating/ shore pipeline, anchoring, etc., workmen as directed by the site-in-charge shall be employed in 3 shifts, each shift consisting of 8 hours on all working days, holidays and Sundays. When the Dredger is under breakdown and demobilised from site, the maintenance gang in shift need not be provided and no payment will be made.
